NEWS RELEASE

Nyene Henry Baker, Jr., a/k/a Jason Anderson, a/k/a “Joshua Irving,” a/k/a “Bryan Smith,” a/k/a Unsco,” a/k/a “Henry,” was charged today in a four-count superseding indictment¹ charging him with conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute 5 kilograms or more of cocaine and marijuana, possession with intent to distribute 500 grams or more of cocaine, leasing a storage unit for the purpose of unlawfully storing and distributing marijuana, and possession with the intent to distribute marijuana, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The superseding indictment alleges that from mid-2007 to February 25, 2010, Baker conspired with other individuals to obtain and transport kilogram quantities of cocaine in Los Angeles and transport the cocaine back to Philadelphia.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum sentence of life imprisonment, with a mandatory minimum of twenty years imprisonment, a \$13 million fine, a mandatory minimum 10 years to lifetime supervised release, and a \$400 special assessment.

This case was investigated by the U.S. Federal Bureau of Investigation and Pennsylvania State Police and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney James R. Pavlock.
