NEWS RELEASE

Jonathan Felix was charged today by indictment¹ with four counts of willfully filing materially false federal income tax returns for tax years 1999 through 2002, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. According to the indictment, Jonathan Felix failed to report gross income of more than \$1.2 million that he earned over a four year period.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 12 years imprisonment, a fine of \$400,000, a special assessment of \$400 and 2 years of supervised release .

The case was investigated by Internal Revenue Service's Criminal Investigation Division and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Floyd J. Miller.
