NEWS RELEASE

PHILADELPHIA - Jay Allen Fisher was charged today in a two-count Indictment¹ with possession of firearms and ammunition by an unlawful user of controlled substances, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. Fisher is the owner of a gun shop doing business as “The Gun Gallery” in Mount Penn, Pennsylvania. The indictment charges that between December 2009 and January 2010, the defendant possessed numerous firearms and ammunition in his home and place of business which he was not authorized to possess.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 10 years in prison, a \$250,000 fine, three years supervised release, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Joseph A. LaBar.
