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NEWS RELEASE

Axel Gonzalez, a/k/a “Baya,” and Alberto Gonzalez, a/k/a “Tito,” were charged today in a three-count Indictment¹ alleging that they conspired to possess a destructive device on or about March 26 through 28, 2010, after having been convicted of a crime punishable by more than one year in custody, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy.

If convicted the defendants face a maximum possible sentence of 25 years imprisonment, three years of supervised release, a \$510,000 fine, and a \$300 special assessment.

The case was investigated by agents from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, and the Philadelphia Police Department, and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Arlene Fisk.
