NEWS RELEASE

Joseph A. Graziola was charged today by information¹ with three counts of mail fraud, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The charges relate to Graziola's operation of a fraudulent credit repair business called Bad Credit Be Gone. The information alleges that Graziola made false claims about his business's ability to repair credit and falsely claimed that his business was staffed with lawyers when it was not. The information alleges that the victims of Graziola's schemes lost more than \$120,000.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of up to 60 years in prison, 5 years of supervised release, up to \$750,000 in fines, and a \$300 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the United States Postal Inspection Service and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Jason Bologna.
