## **NEWS RELEASE**

Hengky Prasetya and Budi Santoso were charged today by Indictment <sup>1</sup> with 11 counts of failure to collect or pay employment taxes and aiding and abetting, in violation of 26 U.S.C. Section 7202 and 18 U.S.C. Section 2, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that Prasetya and Santoso operated Rapid Staffing which provided labor services to various companies in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. According to the indictment, Prasetya and Santoso failed to collect or pay employment taxes to the Internal Revenue Service for the years 2003 to 2007.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 55 years imprisonment, and a fine of \$2,750,000.

The case was investigated by the Internal Revenue Service, Department of the Treasury, Criminal Investigation, and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Roberta Benjamin.
