NEWS RELEASE

Jamar Blackshear and Terrell Davis were charged in an Indictment¹ today with possessing with intent to distribute cocaine, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. Blackshear was also charged with possessing a firearm in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE DEFENDANTS

If convicted of all the charges against him, Blackshear faces a maximum possible sentence of life in prison, a ten year mandatory minimum sentence, a \$5.25 million fine, up to a lifetime of supervised release, and a \$200 special assessment.

If convicted of all the charges against him, Davis faces a maximum possible sentence of 40 years, a five year mandatory minimum sentence, a \$5 million fine, up to a lifetime of supervised release, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives and the Philadelphia Police Department, and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Andrew J. Schell.
