NEWS RELEASE

An indictment¹ was filed today against Martin Gonzalez-Aquilera, a/k/a “Martin Gonzalez-Aquilera,” charging him with one count of reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger . The indictment alleges that on or about March 3, 2011, the defendant was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on August 7, 2005 and again on September 17, 2007

If convicted, Gonzalez-Aquilera faces a maximum 10 year term of imprisonment, 3 years supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) Homeland Security Investigations (“HSI”) and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Melanie B. Wilmoth.
