INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about March 15, 2011, inside Courtroom 12-B of the James A. Byrne Federal Courthouse, located at 601 Market Street, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JULIAN WYNN

threatened to assault and murder J.K., a Federal law enforcement officer of the Federal Protective Service, with intent to impede, intimidate, and interfere with J.K. while he was engaged in, and with intent to retaliate against J.K. on account of, the performance of his official duties.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 115(a)(1)(B).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about March 15, 2011, in the hallway of the James A. Byrne Federal Courthouse, located at 601 Market Street, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant



knowingly and forcibly assaulted, resisted, opposed, impeded, intimidated, and interfered with A.D. and J.H., each a uniformed Court Security Officer, and J.K., a Federal law enforcement officer of the Federal Protective Service, while they were engaged in, and on account of, the performance of their official duties.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 111.
