NEWS RELEASE

Julian Wynn was charged today by indictment¹ with one count of threatening a federal law enforcement officer and one count of forcibly assaulting and resisting an employee of the United States, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that the defendant threatened to assault a Federal law enforcement officer of the Federal Protective Service inside a courtroom in the James A. Byrne Federal Courthouse in Philadelphia, and then forcibly resisted two court security officers who attempted to restrain him.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of seven years imprisonment, a three year period of supervised release, a \$350,000 fine, and a \$125 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the United States Marshals Service and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Kevin R. Brenner.
