Preston Fulton was charged today by Indictment¹ with three counts of passing counterfeit currency, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. According to the indictment, the defendant passed counterfeit \$100 bills in Philadelphia and Fairless Hills in July 2010.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 60 years in prison and a \$750,000 fine.

The case was investigated by the United States Secret Service, and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney David J. Ignall.
