**COUNT ONE**

**THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:**

From in or about January 2010, through on or about October 7, 2010, in Willow Grove, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

**WILLIAM RISKO**

knowingly received visual depictions that had been shipped and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, which visual depictions showed minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct and the producing of those visual depictions involved the use of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(2).

**COUNT TWO**

**THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about October 7, 2010, in Willow Grove, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

**WILLIAM RISKO**

knowingly possessed a laptop computer and thumb drives which contained more than 600 visual depictions that had been shipped and transported using a means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce and in affecting interstate and foreign commerce. The production of these visual depictions involved the use of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct and the visual depictions were of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

**THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252(a)(2) and (4), set forth in this information, defendant

**WILLIAM RISKO**

shall forfeit to the United States of America visual depictions described in the above sections, and any property used or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate the commission of such violations, including, but not limited to:

1. One Fujitsu Lifebook, laptop computer, serial number R2300529;
2. One Lexar thumb drive, 8 GB; and
3. One San Disk thumb drive, 4 GB.

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.
