Terry Trapp was charged today by Indictment¹ with five counts of passing counterfeit currency, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. According to the indictment, the defendant passed counterfeit \$100 bills in Quakertown, West Hempstead, and Lancaster from November 2009 through January 2010.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 100 years in prison and a \$1,250,000 fine.
