NEWS RELEASE

An indictment¹ was filed today against Roger Lee Day charging him with one count of bank robbery, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about January 7, 2011, Day robbed the Citizen's Bank at 7327 Frankford Ave., in Philadelphia, of approximately \$1,385.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of twenty years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, restitution, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Philadelphia Police Department, and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Albert S. Glenn.
