NEWS RELEASE

Lori Graziola was charged today by indictment¹ with two counts of mail fraud, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The charge relates to Graziola's application for home equity line of credit from Quicken Loans. The indictment alleges that Graziola made false claims in her application concerning her employment and income.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of up to 40 years in prison, 3 years of supervised release, up to \$500,000 in fines, and a \$200 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the United States Postal Inspection Service and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Jason Bologna.
