INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 2, 2010 in Allentown, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

RAMON REYMUNDO JUAREZ-ARTEAGA

an alien and native and citizen of El Salvador, who had previously been deported and removed from the United States on or about August 20, 2009, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully re-entered the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 2, 2010 in Allentown, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

RAMON REYMUNDO JUAREZ-ARTEAGA,

while being an alien illegally and unlawfully in the United States, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm and ammunition, that is, (i) a Remington Model 700.30-06 hunting rifle, serial number G6253303; (ii) a Remington model 700.30-60 hunting rifle, serial number A6332247; and 17 live rounds of ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(5)(A).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(5)(A), set forth in this indictment, defendant

RAMON REYMUNDO JUAREZ-ARTEAGA

shall forfeit to the United States of America all firearms and ammunition involved in the commission of such offense, including, but not limited to:

- a. one Remington Model 700 .30-06 hunting rifle, serial number G6253303;
- b. one Remington Model 700 .30-60 hunting rifle, serial number A6332247;

and

- c. 17 live rounds of ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
