## **NEWS RELEASE**

Ramon Reymundo Juarez-Arteaga was charged today by Indictment <sup>1</sup> with unlawful reentry after deportation and possession of a firearm by an illegal alien, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of twelve years of imprisonment, a \$500,000 fine, not more than three years supervised release and a \$200 special assessment.

The case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcment Homeland Security Investigations and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Linwood C. Wright, Jr.
