INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 6, 2011, in Allentown, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

CHRISTOPHER J. LONDON

forcibly assaulted, resisted, opposed, impeded, intimidated and interfered with officers of the United States, as designated in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1114, that is, supervisory Deputy U.S. Marshal Bryant M. Semenza ("Deputy Marshal Semenza"), while Deputy Marshal Semenza was engaged in the performance of his official duties, and thereby inflicted bodily injury upon him, by forcibly grabbing him and striking his (defendant LONDON's) head into the

side of Deputy Marshal Semenza's face, causing Deputy Marshal Semenza to bleed and requiring multiple stitches to close the wound.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 111(a)(1).
