CHILD PORNOGRAPHER SENTENCED TO 3 YEARS

PHILADELPHIA - Adam Jay Lublin, 42, of West Chester and Bryn Mawr, PA, was sentenced today to 36 months in prison for possession of child pornography, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. Lublin pleaded guilty to the charge January 15, 2010.

On October 8, 2009, the defendant possessed more than 600 still images of child pornography on his computers' hard drives. Each image contained a visual depiction of a child or children engaged in sexually explicit conduct. Additionally, some of the images were of small children being raped which necessarily involved pain, and were therefore images portraying sadistic or masochistic conduct and other depictions of violence. The defendant distributed some of the images that he possessed through use of the Internet.

In addition to the prison term, U.S. District Court Judge John R. Padova ordered Lublin to pay a fine of \$500 and to complete five years' of supervised release upon completion of his prison sentence.

The case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Homeland Security Investigations and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Kevin R. Brenner.
