DRUG DEALER SENTENCED TO MORE THAN 11 YEARS IN PRISON

PHILADELPHIA - Chuun Pril, a/k/a "Wolf," 32, of Upper Darby, PA, was sentenced today to 140 months in prison for conspiracy to distribute MDMA ("ecstasy"). Pril made at least five trips to Lowell, Massachusetts in 2008 to obtain a supply of MDMA pills. The pills were brought back to the Philadelphia area and sold. The pills were then sold to numerous co-conspirators who then sold the pills to other customers. During the course of the conspiracy, Pril and his co-conspirators distributed approximately 30,000 pills.

In addition to the prison term, U.S. District Court Judge Stewart Dalzell ordered Pril to pay a \$2,000 fine and to complete six years of supervised release.

The case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Homeland Security Investigations and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Andrea G. Foulkes and Daniel A. Velez.
