INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

At all times relevant to this indictment:

1. Omega Auto Sales, located at 6441 Dickens Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, was a business engaged in interstate commerce, involving commercial activities within the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and elsewhere, including but not limited to, the sale of used cars.

THE ROBBERY CONSPIRACY

2. On or about July 13, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendants

**TAUKEEQ SADAT and
BASIL SOLOMAN,
a/k/a "Bruce Robinson,"**

conspired and agreed to commit robbery, which robbery would unlawfully obstruct, delay, and affect commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce, in that defendants SADAT and SOLOMAN conspired to unlawfully take and obtain money and other items of value from the persons and in the presence of employees of Omega Auto Sales, against their will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to their persons and property in their possession, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a), (b)(1), and (b)(3).

MANNER AND MEANS

3. It was part of the conspiracy that defendants TAUKEEQ SADAT and BASIL SOLOMAN agreed to rob, and robbed, Omega Auto Sales at gunpoint to obtain cash and items of value from that business and its employees.

OVERT ACTS

In furtherance of the conspiracy, and to effect the object of the conspiracy, defendants TAUKEEQ SADAT and BASIL SOLOMAN committed the following overt acts, among others, in Philadelphia, and elsewhere in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania:

On or about July 13, 2010:

1. Defendants TAUKEEQ SADAT and BASIL SOLOMAN arrived together at Omega Auto Sales to rob that business.
2. After defendants TAUKEEQ SADAT and BASIL SOLOMAN purported to negotiate with the employees of Omega Auto Sales regarding the price of a car, defendants

SADAT and SOLOMAN brandished handguns and subdued three employees of Omega Auto Sales at gunpoint.

3. While pointing their guns at the three employees who were lying on the floor, defendants TAUKEEQ SADAT and BASIL SOLOMAN stole approximately \$2,500 in cash proceeds belonging to the business, cash from an employee, as well as a laptop, bank cards, and a cellular telephone.

4. Defendants TAUKEEQ SADAT and BASIL SOLOMAN then fled from Omega Auto Sales.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

1. Paragraphs 1 and 3, and Overt Acts 1 through 4, of Count One of this indictment are incorporated here.
2. On or about July 13, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendants

**TAUKEEQ SADAT and
BASIL SOLOMAN,
a/k/a "Bruce Robinson,"**

obstructed, delayed, and affected commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce, and attempted to do so, by robbery, in that, defendants SADAT and SOLOMAN unlawfully took and obtained, and aided and abetted the unlawful taking and obtaining of, money, and other things of value, from the persons and in the presence of employees of Omega Auto Sales, against their will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to their persons and property in their possession, that is, by brandishing a firearm, demanding money from, and threatening these employees.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1951(a) and 2.

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 13, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendants

**TAUKEEQ SADAT and
BASIL SOLOMAN,
a/k/a "Bruce Robinson,"**

knowingly used and carried, and aided and abetted the use and carrying of, a firearm, that is, a handgun, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which each defendant may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, conspiracy to commit robbery which interfered with interstate commerce, and robbery which interfered with interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1951(a) and 2.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(c)(1) and 2.
