**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about February 17, 2010, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**YEURIS ALEXANDER VASQUEZ-FLORES,  
a/k/a “Yeuris Vasquez,”  
a/k/a “Ramon Martinez,”  
a/k/a “Juan Martinez-Flores,”**

an alien, and native and citizen of the Dominican Republic, who had previously been deported and removed from the United States on or about September 26, 2007, and December 28, 2009, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully reentered the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and (b)(2).
