**NEWS RELEASE**

An indictment<sup>1</sup> was filed today against Yeuris Alexander Vasquez-Flores, a/k/a “Yeuris Vasquez,” a/k/a “Ramon Martinez,” a/k/a “Juan Martinez-Flores,” charging him with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about February 17, 2010, Vasquez-Flores, an alien, and native and citizen of the Dominican Republic, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about September 26, 2007, and December 28, 2009.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of twenty years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) Homeland Security Investigations. It is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Sarah L. Grieb.
