NEWS RELEASE

Christopher Paul Turner, a/k/a "Christopher Turner," a/k/a "Julius Williams," was charged today by indictment¹ with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane D. Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about June 12, 2011, Turner, an alien, and native and citizen of Jamaica, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about October 11, 2001, March 16, 2005 and June 25, 2009.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of twenty years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Ewald Zittlau.
