## **NEWS RELEASE**

Victor Beckwith, Durrell Brown and Lawrence Brown were charged in an indictment<sup>1</sup> with conspiracy to commit armed bank robbery, armed bank robbery, and aiding and abetting, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment specifically charges that Beckwith, Durrell Brown and Lawrence Brown robbed the PNC Bank, located at 2200 Cottman Avenue, Philadelphia, PA on June 16, 2011.

If convicted of all charges, the defendants face a total maximum sentence of 30 years imprisonment, 3 years supervised release, a \$500,000 fine, and a \$200 special assessment.

This case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Salvatore L. Astolfi.
