NEWS RELEASE

An indictment¹ was filed today against Teodoro Moran, a/k/a "Teodoro Moran Morin," a/k/a "Teodoro Morin-Moran,"charging him with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about May 18, 2011, Moran, an alien, and native and citizen of Mexico, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about September 16, 2010.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of twenty years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE"), Homeland Security Investigations ("HSI") and is being prosecuted by Special Assistant United States Attorney Robert J. Sander.
