COUNT TWO

COUNT THREE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 18, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

WILLIAM CASERTA

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Citizens Bank, 6601 Roosevelt Boulevard, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$630, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
