## **NEWS RELEASE**

Lee Graves was charged today by indictment<sup>1</sup> with attempting to possess 500 grams or more of cocaine, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger.

## INFORMATION REGARDING THE DEFENDANT

If convicted of the charge, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of life in prison, a fine of up to \$4 million, a lifetime of supervised release with a mandatory minimum of ten years supervised release, and a special assessment of \$100. The defendant also faces a mandatory minimum sentence of ten years in prison.

The case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Andrew J. Schell.
