INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about November 18, 2010, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

**BRENTON NEWSOME,
a/k/a "John Smarth,"
a/k/a "Allen Newsome,"
a/k/a "Barrington Newsome,"**

an alien, and native and citizen of Jamaica, who had previously been deported and removed from the United States on or about December 16, 1997, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully reentered the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and (b)(2).
