TWO MEN CHARGED WITH POSSESSING COUNTERFEIT CURRENCY

An indictment¹ was filed today charging defendant Kmonte Pour with possessing and concealing approximately \$8,000 in counterfeit U.S. currency, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment also charges defendant Toe Draper with possessing and attempting to pass approximately \$700 in counterfeit U.S. currency.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE DEFENDANTS

If convicted of all charges, Pour and Draper face a maximum possible sentence of 20 years imprisonment, a three year period of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Secret Service and the Philadelphia Police Department and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Vineet Gauri.
