## **INDICTMENT**

## **COUNT ONE**

### THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about February 27, 2011, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

### JAMES WRIGHT,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce a firearm, that is, a Haskell Model JS45, .45 caliber semi-automatic pistol, serial #028723, loaded with 3 live rounds of ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

# **NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

### THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

### **JAMES WRIGHT**

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of this offense, including, but not limited to:

- (a) the Haskell Model JS45, .45 caliber semi-automatic pistol, serial #028723; and
- (b) the 3 live rounds of ammunition removed from the firearm described in Paragraph (a) above.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
