Today, James Wright was charged in a one-count indictment¹ with possession of a firearm in Philadelphia after having been convicted of a crime punishable by more than one year in prison, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger and Philadelphia District Attorney R. Seth Williams.

If convicted, the defendant faces a statutory maximum sentence of ten years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, three years supervised release, and \$100 special assessment.

This case is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, a federal initiative designed to identify and prosecute firearms offenders in federal court, where the defendant is likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction.

This case was investigated by the Philadelphia Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigations. It is being prosecuted by Special Assistant United States Attorney Joseph Whitehead, Jr.
