knowingly attempted to procure and obtain, contrary to law, and procured and obtained,

naturalization as a United States citizen for himself, by making in connection with his

application for naturalization false statements, sworn under oath, during an interview with an

official of the United States Immigration Service and on Form N-400 that he was "Cuu Van

Truong," when in fact, as defendant BUI knew, this statement was false and fictitious.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1425(b).
