NEWS RELEASE

An indictment¹ was filed today against Felipe Esquivel-Hernandez, a/k/a "Felipe Esquivel," a/k/a "Marcos Esquivel," charging him with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about April 15, 2011, Esquivel-Hernandez, an alien, and native and citizen of Mexico, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about November 13, 2007.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of ten years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement's ("ICE") Homeland Security Investigations ("HSI"), and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Daniel A. Velez.
