NEWS RELEASE

An Indictment¹ was filed today charging defendant Leslie Mosby with one count of carjacking, and one count of using and carrying a firearm during a crime of violence, announced U.S. Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment specifically charges that Mosby committed a gun-point carjacking in Philadelphia on November 21, 2010. Mosby is also charged with using, carrying, and discharging a firearm during the carjacking charged in the indictment.

If convicted of all counts, Mosby faces a maximum sentence of life imprisonment, with a mandatory 10 year minimum sentence, consecutive to any other sentence imposed, a \$500,000 fine, five years supervised release and a \$200 special assessment.

This case has been investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) and the Philadelphia Police Department. The case has been assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Thomas M. Zaleski.
