## **NEWS RELEASE**

Ceferino Penaloza-Arana, a/k/a "Ceferino Penaloza-Aranda," was charged today by Indictment<sup>1</sup> with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about October 7, 2011, Penaloza-Arana, an alien, and native and citizen of Mexico, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about February 20, 1993, March 26, 1994, October 18, 2004 and October 27, 2004.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 20 years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by Immigration and Customs Enforcement("ICE") Homeland Security Investigations and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Katayoun Copeland.
