SUPERSEDING INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

From a date unknown to the grand jury, but at least on or about April 3, 2011, until on or about May 12, 2011, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

TERRELL HAMPTON,

having been convicted in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a Springfield Armory, model XD .40 caliber pistol, serial number US279578.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

TERRELL HAMPTON

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of such offense, including, but not limited to:

1. a Springfield Armory model XD .40 caliber pistol, serial number US279578; and
2. thirteen .40 caliber rounds of ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
