NEWS RELEASE

A superseding indictment¹ was filed today against Terrell Hampton, charging him with one count of being a felon in possession of a firearm, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that between about April 3, 2011 and May 12, 2011, Hampton, who had previously been convicted of a crime with a maximum period of imprisonment of more than one year, was found in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in possession of a firearm loaded with 13 live rounds of ammunition.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of ten years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the United States Secret Service, and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Paul G. Shapiro.
