NEWS RELEASE

An indictment¹ was unsealed today charging Kendall Price with being a convicted felon in possession of a firearm, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment charges that on or about March 4, 2011, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Price, after having been convicted of a felony, possessed one Taurus PT 111 9mm semiautomatic pistol that had its serial number obliterated and that was loaded with nine live rounds of ammunition.

If convicted, Price faces a maximum possible sentence of 10 years imprisonment, 3 years supervised release, and a \$250,000 fine.

The case was investigated by the Philadelphia Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Gerald B. Sullivan. This case is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, a federal initiative designed to identify and prosecute firearms offenders in federal court, where the defendant is likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction.
