NEWS RELEASE

Rey Arellano-Mondragon, a/k/a "Rey Modragon Arellano," was charged today by Indictment¹ with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane D. Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about August 4, 2011, Arellano Mondragon, an alien, and native and citizen of Mexico, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about February 6, 2001 and January 10, 2005.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of ten years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") Homeland Security Investigations ("HSI") and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Andrea Foulkes.
