## **INDICTMENT**

#### **COUNT ONE**

#### THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about November 22, 2010, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

AKI JONES, a/k/a "Akeem Jones," a/k/a "Aki D. Jones,"

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a Sturm Ruger & Co. .44 caliber revolver, Model Super Redhawk, serial number 530-05931, loaded with five live .44 caliber rounds of ammunition and one spent .44 caliber ammunition round.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

### **NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

# THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), as set forth in this indictment, defendant

AKI JONES, a/k/a "Akeem Jones," a/k/a "Aki D. Jones"

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of such offense, including, but not limited to:

- 1. Sturm Ruger & Co., .44 caliber revolver, Model Super Redhawk, serial number 530-05931; and
- 2. five live rounds of .44 caliber ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
