NEWS RELEASE

David R. Liss was charged today in a three-count information¹ with conspiracy to traffic in counterfeit goods, trafficking in counterfeit goods, and mail fraud, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The information alleges that from at least 2007 through March of 2011, Liss trafficked in counterfeit goods, specifically counterfeit sports merchandise, which was supplied by unknown persons from the People's Republic of China.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 35 years imprisonment, three years supervised release, and a \$2.5 million fine.

The case was investigated by agents from Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") Homeland Security Investigations ("HSI"), and the United States Postal Inspection Service. It is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Robert K. Reed.
