NEWS RELEASE

Fresa Pichardo, Samuel Diaz-Rivera, and Bannessa Aybar-Caimares were charged today by Indictment¹ with conspiracy and attempted possession with intent to distribute approximately eight kilograms of cocaine, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger.

If convicted the defendants face a mandatory minimum of ten years in prison up to life, a fine of up to \$8 million, at least five years supervised release, and a \$200 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and the Elizabeth (NJ) Police Department. It is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Anita Eve.
