NEWS RELEASE

Desiderio Cacaeres-Meras, a/k/a “Desiderio Mejia,” a/k/a “Roberto Mejia,” a/k/a “Roberto Mejia-Garcia,” 27, of Honduras, was charged today by Indictment¹ with one count of illegal reentry after deportation, announced United States Attorney Zane David Memeger. The indictment alleges that on or about August 15, 2012, Cacaeres-Meras, an alien, and native and citizen of Honduras, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about September 17, 2010.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of twenty years.

The case was investigated by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Joseph J. Khan.
