**MAN SENTENCED FOR ILLEGALLY
REENTERING UNITED STATES**

Madison, Wis. - John W. Vaudreuil, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Daniel Sandoval-Velasquez, 45, a citizen of Mexico found in Darlington, Wis., was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge William Conley to 46 months in prison without parole for illegally reentering the United States after having been deported. Sandoval-Velasquez pleaded guilty to this charge on June 23, 2010.

Sandoval-Velasquez was removed from the United States in 2007 following a conviction for selling cocaine. He reentered the United States in March 2010 and was caught using false identification in order to obtain employment.

The charge against Sandoval-Velasquez was the result of an investigation conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Rita Rumbelow.
