**MAN SENTENCED TO 37 MONTHS  
FOR DISTRIBUTING COCAINE**

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Vincent H. DeSantiago-Tinoco, 31, Queretaro, Mexico, was sentenced on August 3, 2010, by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to 37 months in prison for distributing 749 grams of cocaine. Pursuant to federal law, this sentence will be served without the possibility of parole and DeSantiago-Tinoco will be deported after he completes his sentence.

United States Attorney Sinnott stated that the charges followed an investigation conducted by the Dane County Narcotics and Gang Task Force, the Drug Enforcement Administration, and Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives. Prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Timothy M. O'Shea.
