**MADISON MAN SENTENCED TO SIX YEARS  
ON CRACK COCAINE CHARGE**

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Valonbea T. Randolph, 31, of Madison, Wisconsin, was sentenced yesterday by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to six years in prison without parole for possessing crack cocaine with the intent to distribute it. This term of imprisonment will be followed by four years of supervised release. Randolph pleaded guilty to this charge on May 19, 2010.

Randolph sold crack cocaine to an undercover officer six times. A search warrant was later executed at his home and officers found approximately 34 grams of crack cocaine, a handgun, and \$4,000.

The charges against Randolph were the result of an investigation conducted by the Dane County Narcotics and Gang Task Force. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Elizabeth Altman.
