TWO OFFICIALS OF BOYCEVILLE COMPANY
SENTENCED TO PROBATION ON TAX CHARGE

Madison, Wis. - John W. Vaudreuil, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Jennie Evenson, 55, of Boyceville, Wis., and Nancy Smith, 58, of Glenwood City, Wis., were sentenced yesterday by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to one year probation for failing to deposit and pay over to the Internal Revenue Service all of the federal income taxes withheld and Federal Insurance Contributions Act (FICA) taxes due and owing to the United States on behalf of JeNan Corp. d/b/a All American Manufacturing. Evenson and Smith both pleaded guilty to this felony charge on October 21, 2010.

Evenson and Smith held positions of director and vice president, respectively, of JeNan Corp. d/b/a All American Manufacturing in Boyceville.

The charges against Jennie Evenson and Nancy Smith were the result of an investigation conducted by Internal Revenue Service. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Robert A. Anderson.
