MENOMONIE WOMAN PLEADS GUILTY TO BANK EMBEZZLEMENT

Madison, Wis. - John W. Vaudreuil, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Becky L. Jensen, 51, of Menomonie, Wis., pleaded guilty yesterday in U.S. District Court in Madison to bank embezzlement.

U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb scheduled sentencing for March 1, 2011. Jensen faces a maximum penalty of 30 years in prison.

At the plea hearing, Jensen admitted embezzling approximately \$28,000 from her former employer, Bremer Bank, Eau Galle, Wis.

The charge against Jensen was the result of an investigation conducted by the Eau Claire office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Grant C. Johnson.
