MINNESOTA MAN SENTENCED FOR GUN CRIME

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Jeffrey A. Guy, 29, Lino Lakes, Minn., was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge Lynn Adelman to sixteen months in prison without parole for possessing a short-barreled shotgun. The prison term will be followed by three years of supervised release. Guy pleaded guilty to this charge on August 6, 2009.

In April 2008, Guy sawed off the barrel of a stolen shotgun and sold it to a confidential informant. In May 2008, he sold a pistol and some cocaine to the informant.

The charges against Guy were the result of an investigation conducted by the Duluth (Minnesota) Police Department, Lake Superior Drug and Gang Force, and Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Elizabeth Altman.
